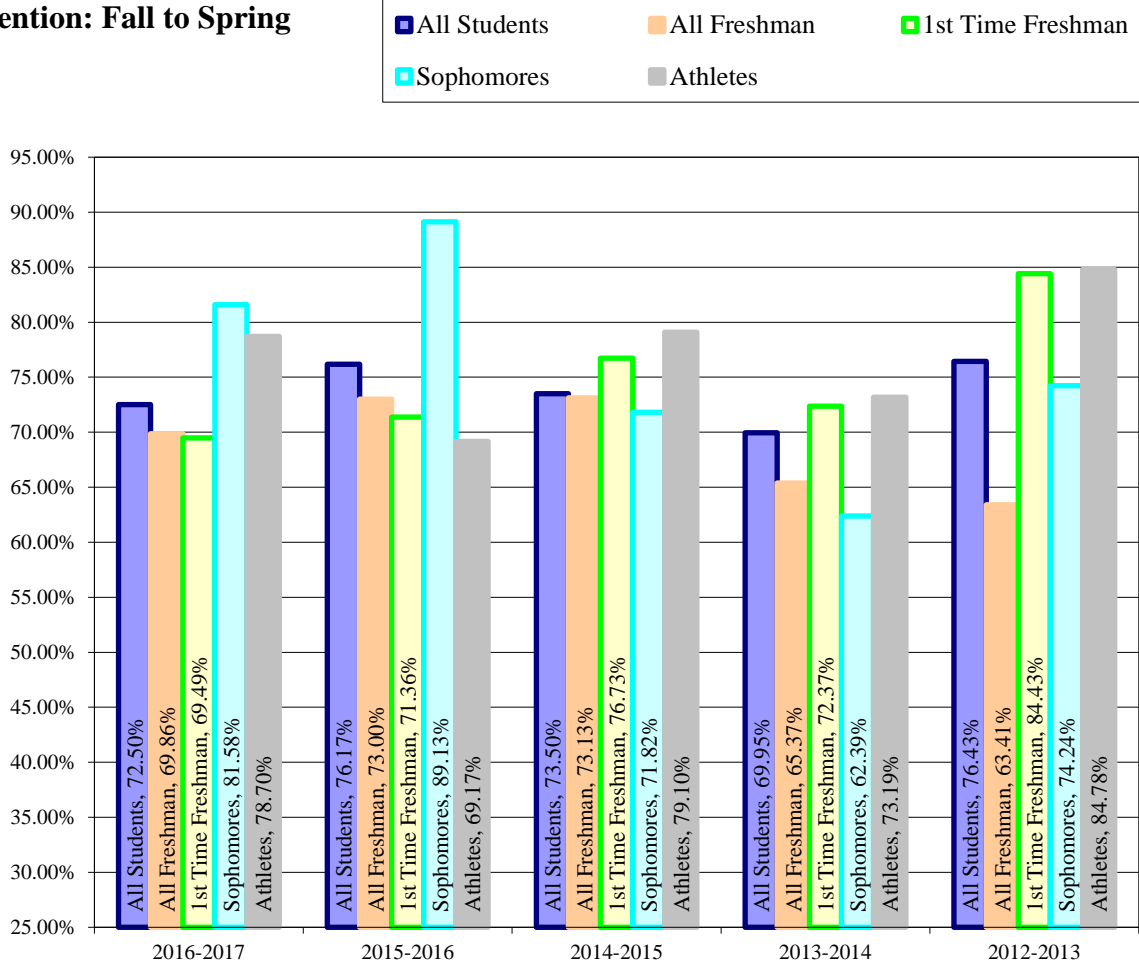


### Retention - Fall to Spring - 1st Time Freshman

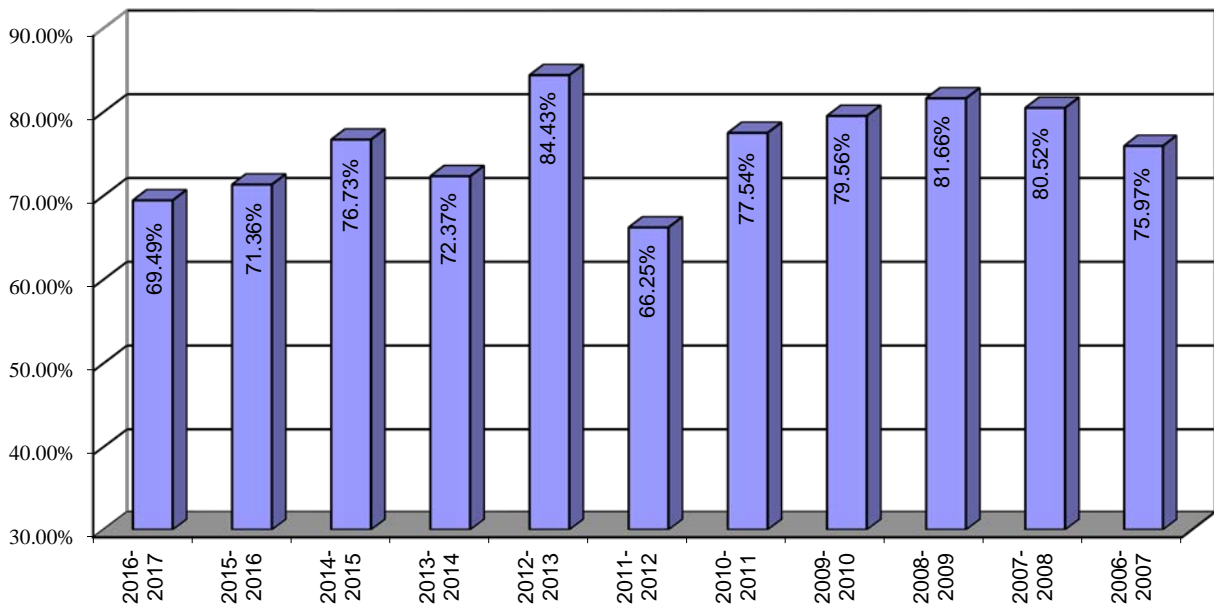

**Country of Citizenship Count**



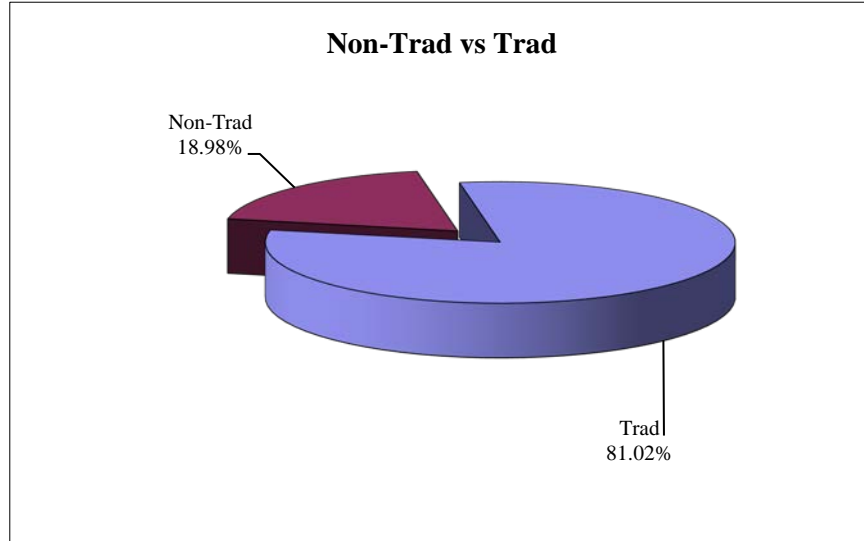

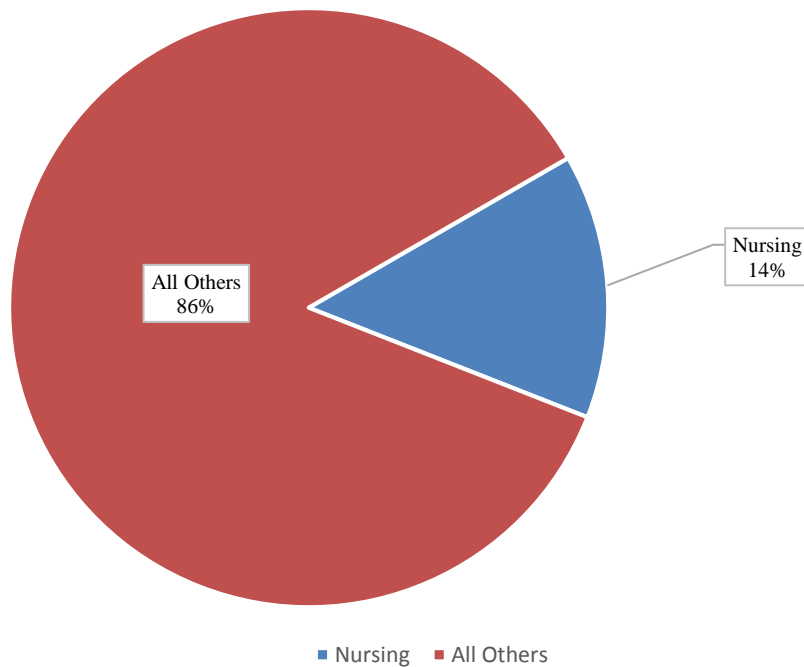
